A Personal Word

Tim and Maggie joined Wycliffe in 1995. After their initial training, they moved to Senegal along with their two daughters, Ruth and Anna.

There they worked with Wycliffe's partner organisation, SIL, assisting Mankanya speakers to develop an alphabet for their language and then to translate the New Testament and portions of the Old Testament into it. They were also involved in the continuing development of the Mankanya language, including helping to produce materials to teach people who speak Mankanya to read and write their language. Both printed and audio versions of Genesis and the New Testament have been available to the Mankanya people since 2015 along with some other portions of the Bible.

In addition to their involvement with the Mankanya language, Tim and Maggie were both involved with many other languages in Senegal -Tim helping with linguistics and Maggie giving oversight to all the SIL projects in the country.

They returned to the UK in 2012 where they are now based. For several years, Maggie worked in church relations for Wycliffe UK whilst Tim combined computer support, archiving and other work for Senegal and finishing his training to be a linguistics consultant.

At the end of 2019, Tim started working as a linguistics consultant for Wycliffe's partner organisation, SIL, in Côte d'Ivoire. He is part of a team of linguists working with Bible translation teams in Burkina Faso, Côte d'Ivoire, Mali and Niger. Good linguistics is the basis for a good translation, and a linguistics consultant helps others really understand the languages they're working on and so produce translations that communicate well. He also continues to be involved with archiving work in Senegal.

Since 2017, Maggie has been part of the SIL Francophone Africa Team, which supports Bible translation and language development in French-speaking West and Central Africa. One of her roles is to support the management of language programmes in the region by assisting, training, mentoring and resourcing the SIL personnel involved in those roles. Her other role is as a strategic planning coach working with leadership teams throughout French-speaking Africa.

Maggie and Tim are excited to be part of SIL's mission to advocate, build capacity, and work with local communities to apply language expertise that advances meaningful development, education and engagement with Scripture.
